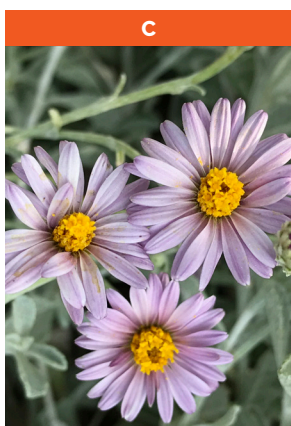

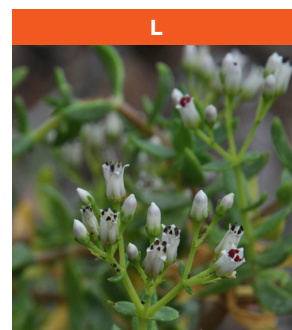

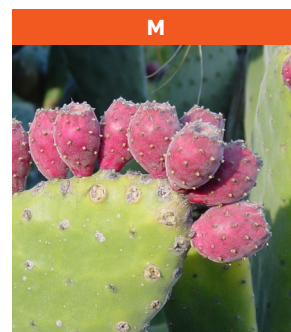

*Crassula sarcocaulis*

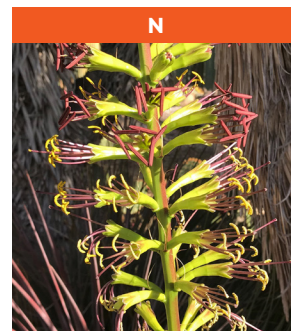
Native to southeastern Africa

*Opuntia tomentosa* (fruit)

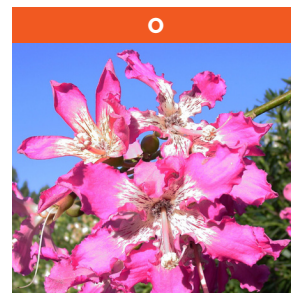
Tree-like prickly pear

*Ceiba speciosa*

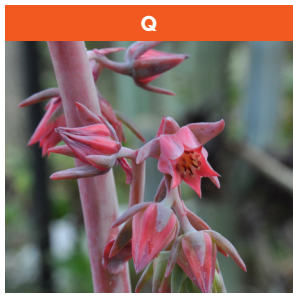
(*Chorisia speciosa*;

Hardy to 20° F

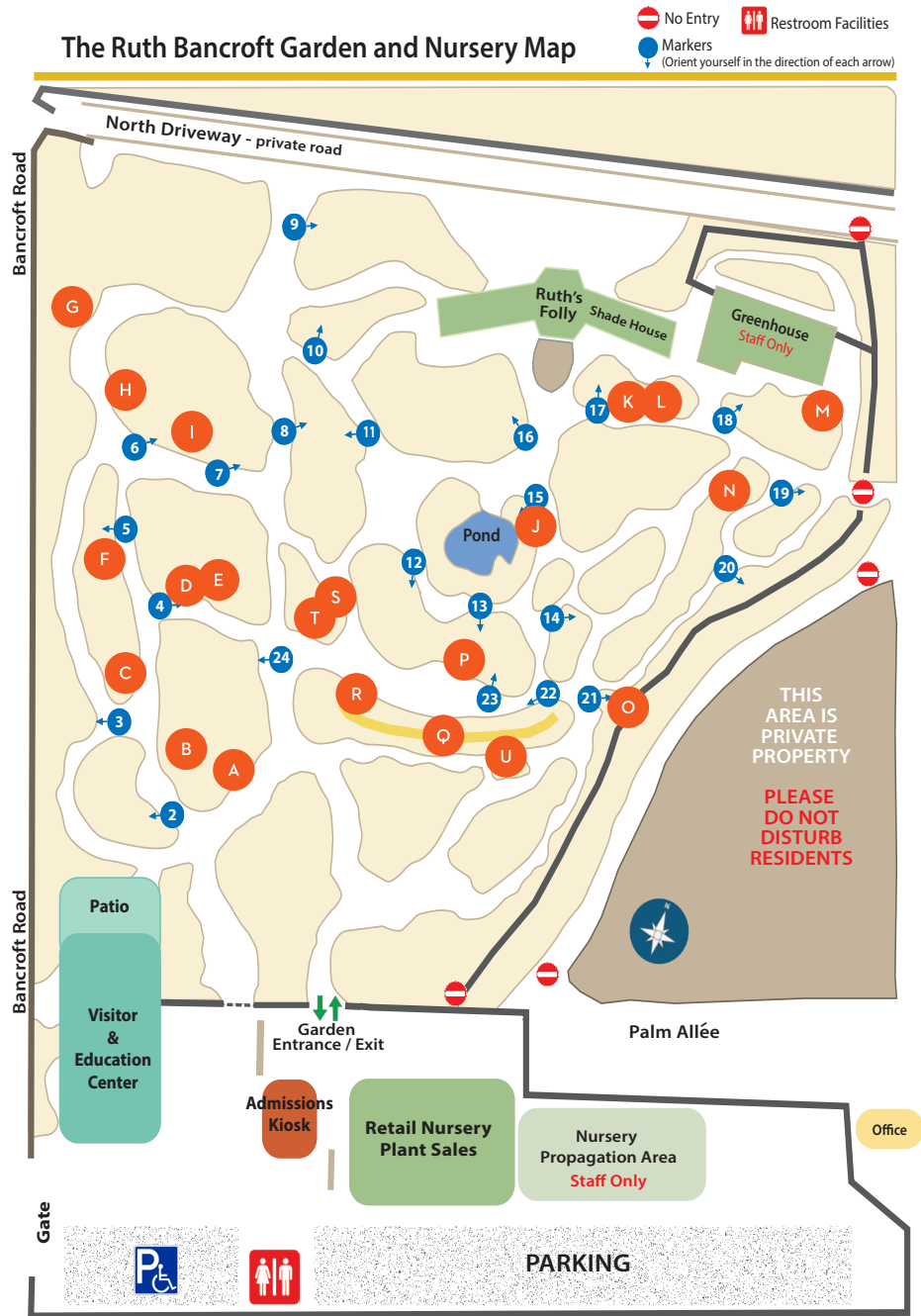
