Hardy to low 20s

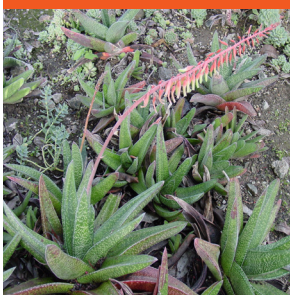

Full sun / Hardy to 26°F

Native to South Africa  
Clump-forming & stemless  
with rosettes to 2½ ft. θ  
Filtered sun  
Hardy to 20° F

***Aloe comptonii x capitata***

Hybrid; parents from  
S. Africa & Madagascar  
Clumper w/ rosettes to 3 ft. θ  
Full sun to partial shade  
Hardy to 27° F

***Aloe capitata x cryptopoda***

Hybrid, with parents from  
Madagascar and South Africa  
Stemless clumper,  
to 2½ feet tall  
Full sun to partial shade  
Hardy to mid-20s

***Aquilegia shockleyi***

California native  
Perennial to 2 ft. tall  
Partial shade Hardy to 20° F

***Puya berteroniana***

Native to Chile  
Large bromeliad; clumps to 5  
ft. tall / Full sun  
Hardy to 20° F

Native to eastern Mexico  
Single to several-headed;  
rosettes to 2–3 ft. θ  
Full sun to partial shade  
Hardy to low 20s F

***Manfreda aff. sileri***

Native to Mexico  
Stemless rosettes to 2 ft. θ  
Partial shade  
Hardy to 20° F

***Ferocactus pilosus***

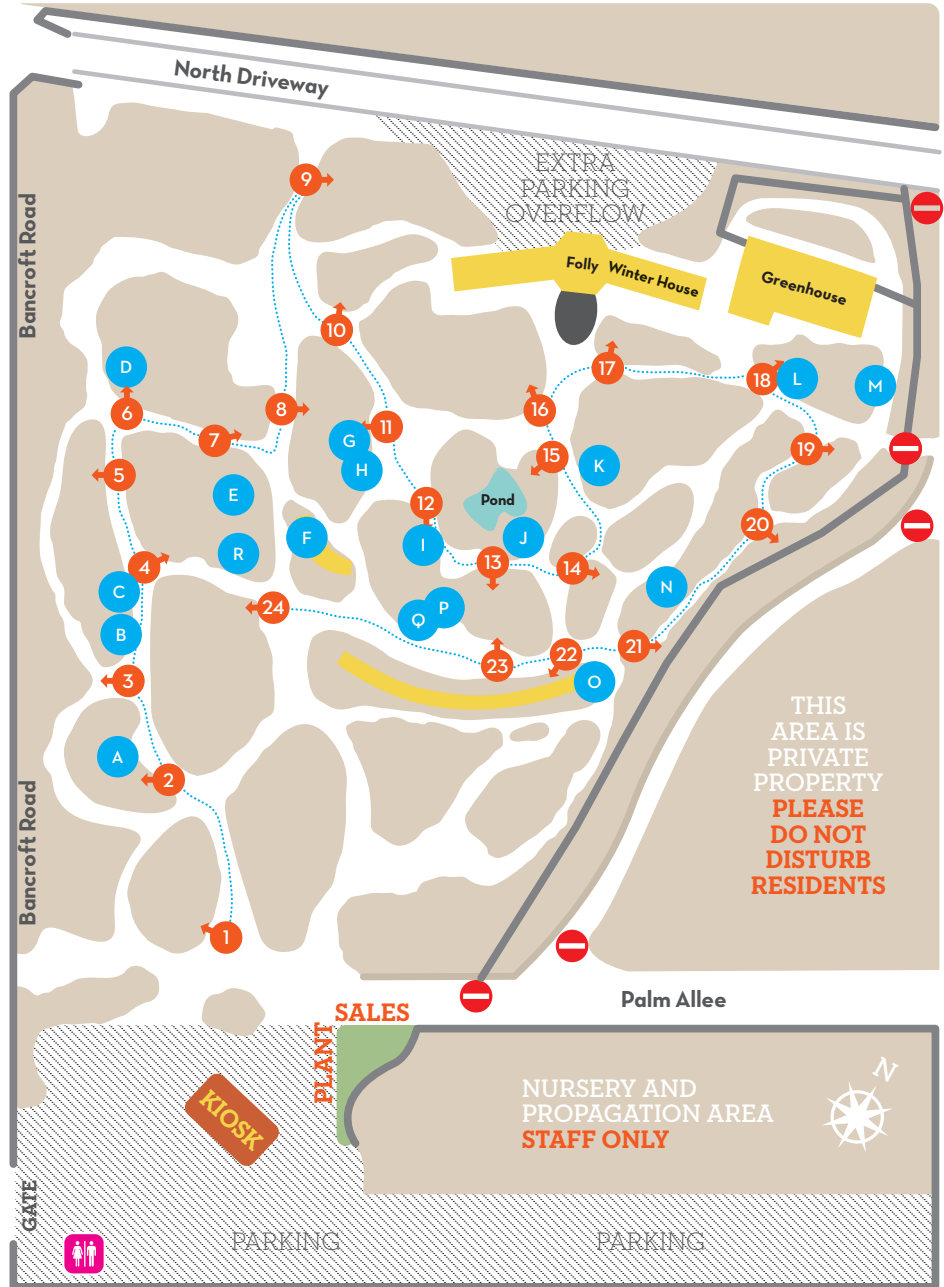
Native to Mexico

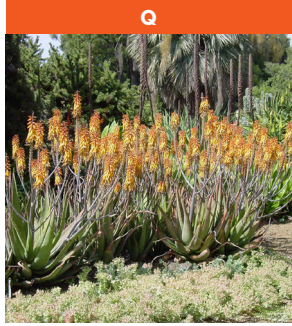

**Opuntia robusta**

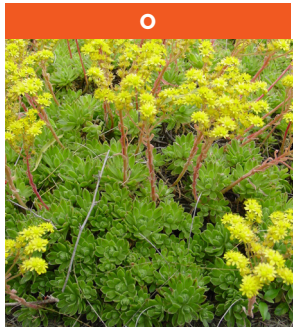
Native to Mexico

**Aloe 'Gibson Hybrid'**

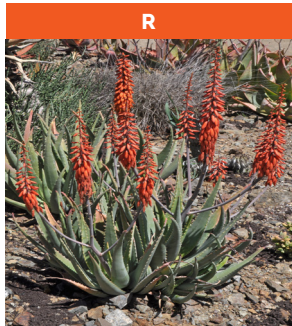
Clump-forming, rosettes to 2 ft.; flow. to 4 ft.

Hardy to mid-20s

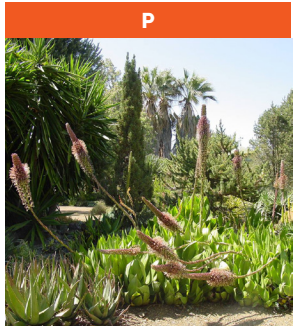

Hardy to 27° F

synonym: *Agave celsii*  
Native to eastern Mexico  
Rosettes to 2 ft. across, eventually forming a large clump  
Full sun to part shade  
Hardy to mid-20s
