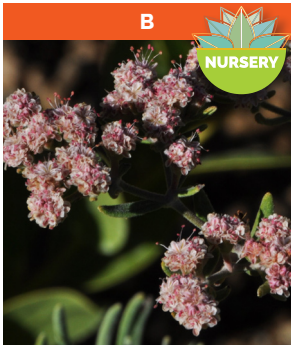




***Epilobium canum***

Full sun  
Hardy to mid-teens F



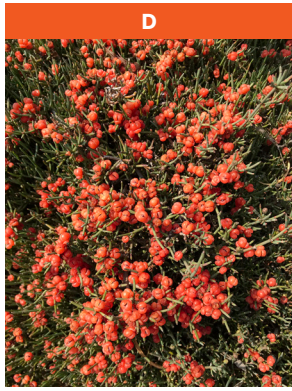
***Eriogonum arborescens***

California native  
Shrub to 3 – 4 ft. tall  
Full sun  
Hardy to upper teens F



***Calliandra 'Sierra Starr'***

Hybrid; parents native to SW USA & Mexico  
Small shrub 4 ft. tall  
Full sun  
Hardy to 15° F



***Ephedra americana var. andina - fruit***

Native to Central Asia  
Shrub to 1ft  
Full sun  
Hardy to 0° F



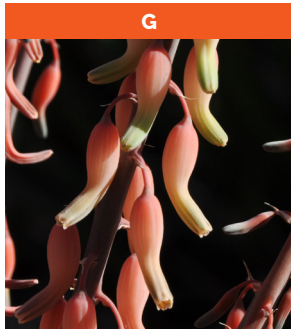
***Sphaeralcea cv.***

Hybrid; parents from SW U.S.  
Small shrub to 4 ft. tall  
Full sun  
Hardy to teens



***Xanthorrhoea quadrangulata***

Native to Australia  
Grass-like head of lvs. to 4 ft. θ  
Hardy to low 20's



***Gasteria excelsa***

Native to South Africa  
Single stemless rosette to 2½ ft. θ  
Shade to part sun  
Hardy to mid-20's



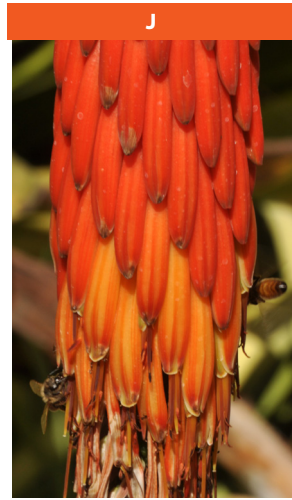
***Bouteloua gracilis 'Blonde Ambition'***

Native to western North America  
Clumping grass to 2ft. tall  
Full sun to half sun  
Hardy to below 0° F



***Dasylirion wheeleri - female***

Native to southwestern U.S. & northern Mexico  
Rosettes to 6' θ  
Full sun to partial shade  
Hardy to 0° F



***Aloe reitzii***

Native to northeastern South Africa  
Stemless single rosettes to 4 ft. θ  
Full sun to partial shade  
Hardy to mid-20's F



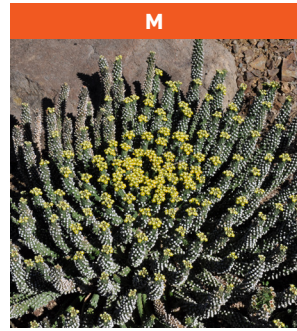
***Aloe maculata hybrid***

Hybrid; full parentage unknown  
Stemless clumper  
Full sun to partial shade  
Hardy to 20° F



***Euphorbia echinus***

Native to Morocco  
Tight clump to 3 ft. θ  
Full sun  
Hardy to 20° F



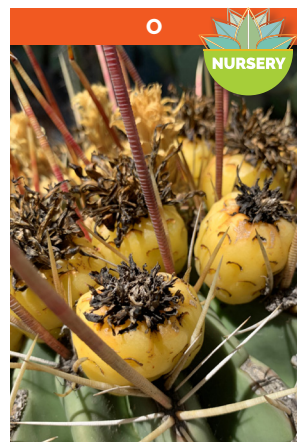
***Euphorbia inermis var. huttoniae***

Native to South Africa  
Stemless "medusoid" euphorbia to 1½ ft. θ (central head & snake-like arms)  
Full sun  
Hardy to upper teens



***Erythrina x bidwillii***

Hybrid (1 parent S. American, 1 N. American)  
Deciduous shrub to 8 ft. tall  
Full sun  
Hardy to 20° F



***Ferocactus emoryi ssp. rectispinus - fruit***

Native to Baja California  
Barrel cactus to 1½ ft. θ  
Full sun  
Hardy to mid-20's F

Large prickly-pear to 12' tall  
Full sun  
Hardy to teens

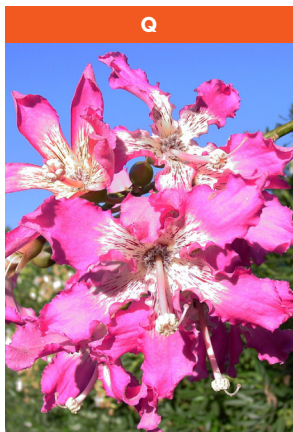

Sprawling herbaceous plant to 3' tall  
Full sun  
Hardy to 15° F

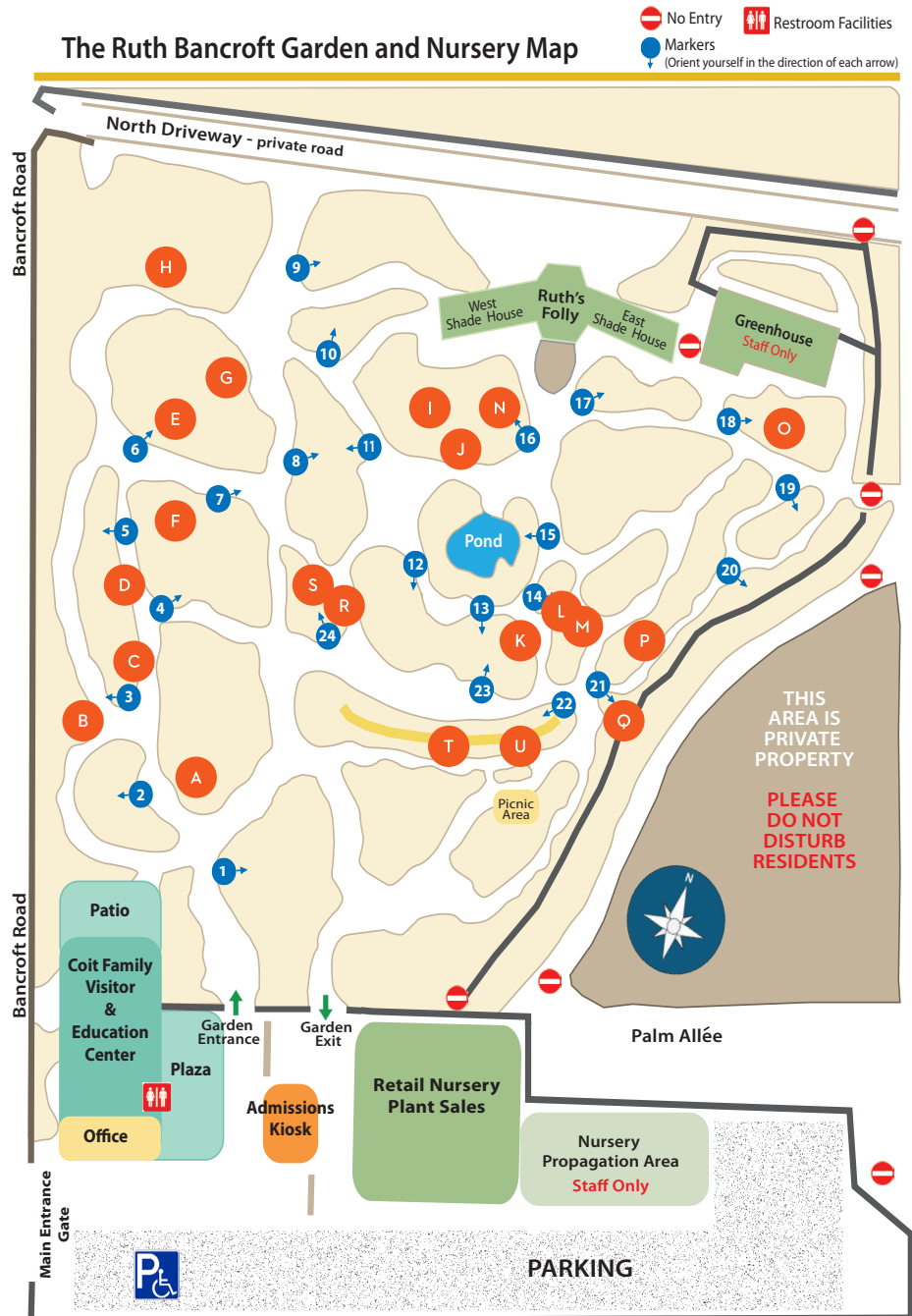
